Early Voting in Monroe County



Key constitutional changes to elections with Proposal 2022-2:

- Created a fundamental right to vote.
- Requires prepaid postage for absentee ballot applications and absentee ballots.
- Requires local clerks to install and maintain at least one absent ballot drop box for every 15,000 registered voters.
- Allows a voter to request an absentee ballot for all future elections with one application.
- **Requires at least 9 days of early voting in statewide and federal elections.**
- Allows a voter to use photo ID or sign an affidavit to verify their identity when voting.
- Requires a state system to track absentee ballot applications and ballots – must allow voters to opt in to receive notifications.
- Requires MOVE absentee ballots postmarked on or before election day received within 6 days after the election to be counted.

What does the Michigan Constitution require for early voting?

- Early voting (EV) in all statewide and federal elections.
- EV is optional in non-statewide elections.
- Voters at EV sites have same rights and requirements as election day polling precincts.
- EV sites **may** serve voters from multiple precincts and municipalities within a county.
- EV sites subject to same requirements as election day precincts except for limits on number of voters.
- EV sites must be opened for at least 9 days starting on the second Saturday before the election.
- EV sites must be open at least 8 hours each day.
- EV ends the Sunday before election day.
- The election official responsible for the EV site **may** open the EV site for additional days and hours.
- Municipalities within a county may work together and share an EV site.
- Municipalities within a county may authorize the county clerk to conduct EV.
- EV results are not generated or reported until after 8:00 pm on election day.

Early Voting Administration

All voters must have an EV site. Every municipality must do one of the following:

- Conduct EV as a **single municipality** as described in MCL 168.720e.
- Enter into a **municipal agreement** and **jointly conduct** EV with one or more municipalities within the same county as described in MCL 168.720f.
- Enter into a **county agreement** and authorize the county to conduct EV as described in MCL 168.720g.



What will EV look like in Monroe County?

- The County Clerk will not conduct EV through a county agreement for 2024.
- Most municipalities in Monroe County will conduct EV as a single municipality - MCL 168.720e.
- Several municipalities will enter agreements and jointly conduct EV – MCL 168.720f.



The following will conduct EV as a single municipality:

- Bedford Township
- Berlin Charter Township
- City of Milan
- City of Monroe
- Frenchtown Charter Township
- Ida Township
- LaSalle Township
- Monroe Charter Township
- Whiteford Township

- Raisinville Township and Dundee Township and Milan Township
- Erie Township and City of Luna Pier
- London Township and Exeter Township
